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Scattered with Unesco-protected ruins, the beach-fringed Peloponnese has been at the heart of Greek culture for millennia. Amanzoe rests on its east coast, a modern-day Acropolis from which 360-degree views encompass olive groves and Aegean blue. The resort comprises of 52 pavilions and villas with private pools opening onto fragrant gardens.

The Amanzoe Beach Club offers four swimming pools, a restaurant, lounging areas, a boutique, several overnight Cabanas, a two-room spa and a gym. A range of complimentary non-motorised water sports are on offer while speedboats await to sail between nearby islands.

Drawing on classic Greek architecture, Amanzoe's standalone pavilions all open onto terraces with private plunge pools and views of the surrounding land and sea. Each Pavilion is accessed via a stone-walled courtyard, leading to high-ceiling interiors. Amanzoe's Villas feature open terraces with marble floors, dry stone-clad walls, concrete columns and cornices with a chef and a host on hand to serve each guest.

From the restaurant's Greek and Mediterranean fare to Nama's Japanese cuisine, Amanzoe places the focus on simple flavors, expertly prepared.

The holistic healings of Hippocrates are the inspiration for Amanzoe's light-filled 2,850-square-metre Spa, combining diet, gymnastics, exercise, massage and sea bathing with modern natural products and treatments.
